With Covid-19 such a cause of concern, this is to give notice of a public question for which I and no doubt others would appreciate an answer at the next Virtual Mtg on 18th Feb. 2021:

Farnborough Airport and Quarantine:

In December, Grant Shapps announced that those engaged in business activity of significant benefit to the UK economy will no longer need to self-isolate on arrival from non-exempt countries.

This would not allow those traveling for personal or leisure reasons any such exemption from mandatory quarantine regulations.. In fact, the exemption was cancelled from Monday 18th January 2021, since when, in common with most other users of the airport, business travel again qualifies for self-isolation for 10 days on arrival.

As those present would now be aware, from 15th February, arrivals from certain countries are subject to mandatory hotel quarantine, with no business related exemptions.

**For the benefit of this meeting:**

1. Please would the FACC establish if Farnborough Airport Ltd. has responsibility for passenger and crew registration re. the purpose of travel and any related liability to quarantine?
  - a) If the answer is ‘Yes’; could the meeting be advised as to the reporting procedures and the extent to which such information would be in the public domain?
  - b) If the answer is ‘No’; can we be advised who has the reporting responsibility, including any self-reporting, and whether the airport has a monitoring role for compliance?
2. (Possible follow-up) Should FAL consider this is a personal, private or 3rd party matter, can we be advised of the relevant legislation or guidance relied upon for such advice?
