The group debated the issue and unanimously recommended to the full FACC that NATS should be seen as providing special advice across all groups and should not be aligned with either the LAs, residents/special interest groups or Business/operators. NATS place on the business/operators group should be taken by the Chamber of Commerce. The moving of the Chamber frees up a seat for Church Crookham Parish council on the residents group. This has the advantage that all “economic” interest groups will come together. We will have in effect Groups of Residents, Local authorities and Business.

Having consulted the National Association of Consultative Committees they are not aware of any committee which has NATS as a member. Some call in NATS when specialist advice is needed others ask NATS to attend all meetings to participate when needed.

The full committee is invited to endorse this recommendation.
