**Item 2. Minutes of Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> July and Matters Arising**

The minutes were agreed as a correct record. There were no matters arising.

**Item 3. TAG Information Reports**

Brandon O'Reilly reported that the airport had been at its busiest since 2007 and that next year he anticipates that there would continue to be an increase in the number of movements. Some of this increase will be as a result of Northolt being closed for part of next year. The number of large aircraft movements is 7% down. August was the busiest month with 140 movements of these larger aircraft types and October had the highest number of total movements for that month since 2007 and September had the highest number of movements for any September on record.

The M3 development into a Smart motorway is being promoted as it will enable clients to reach London more easily.

The twilight run raised £6,500 for local charities and TAG has promoted Music in the Park which raised £85,000.

Airshow Hall 1 construction is going well and moves are in hand to change the name of the southern access road to Trenchard Way in recognition of Hugh Trenchard known as father of the RAF.

**Item 4. TAG Reports.**

Miles Thomas presented his report and advised that the increase in complaints for aircraft not on track was partly due to the weather during the summer. Jenny Radley referred to an anomaly within the report relating to the identification of a data error in the TAG Information Report (Summary Table 2, page 6). Jenny Radley asked whether the number of geese on the airfield posed a problem. Roger Walker assured members that measures are in hand to address this.
