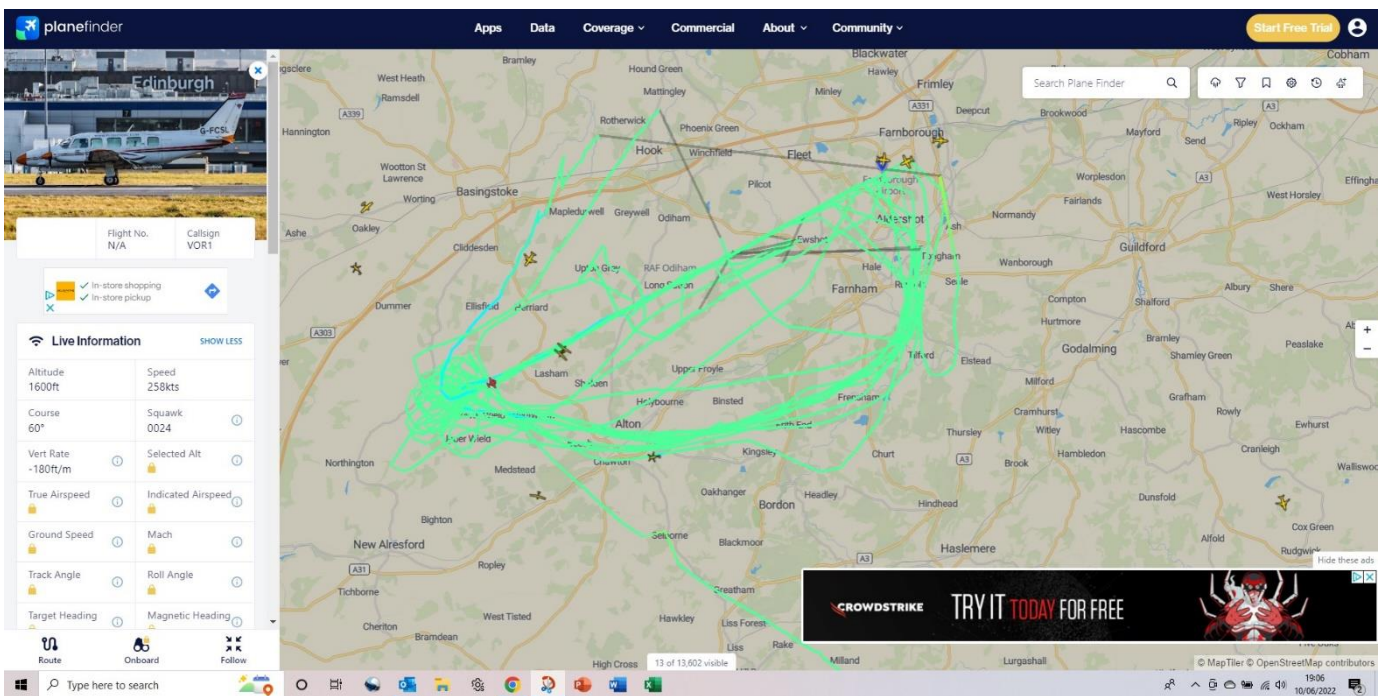


Observations from Mr Shearn

Saturday 10th June was a pleasant sunny day but the area endured nearly six hours of overflying at a height of 1,000 – 1,300 ft by a Farnborough calibration flight. The aircraft passed over the area sixteen times. This is in addition to the many-night time calibration flights that happen throughout the year that people have commented on before. This situation should be recorded as a complaint but also as an issue for discussion in the FACC.

These flights need to be added to the number of Farnborough flights as they are a direct consequence of Farnborough aircraft operations.
